INTRODUCTION

Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; for He is faithful that promised.

—*Hebrews 10:23 (KJV)*

THE BIBLE REVEALS AN ESSENTIAL QUALITY of real faith—it speaks!¹ God’s first creative act was to speak: “Let there be light.”² Jesus is called the “Word of God”—He must have a lot to say!³ And the believer is here exhorted to “hold fast” to his profession of faith. The word “profession” (translated “confession” in NASB and NKJV) comes from the Greek word *homologia* which literally means “to say the same thing.” So, when Christians confess their faith, they are saying the same thing God has said in His Word—they are agreeing with God’s Word and declaring it out loud.

In Romans 10:8-10, the apostle Paul explains how the “Word of Faith” needs to be in two places—in our mouth and in our heart:

But what does it say? “The word is near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart,” that is, the Word of

Faith we are proclaiming: That if you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved.

“Confess” here is derived from the same Greek word *homologeō*, and Paul stresses that this confession is essential to our salvation. He later uses the same word when he commended Timothy for laying hold of eternal life and for having “confessed the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.”⁴

In Mark 11:22-23, Jesus was teaching important principles about faith:

“Have faith in God,” Jesus answered. “I tell you the truth, if anyone *says* [emphasis added] to this mountain, ‘Go, throw yourself into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart but believes that what he *says* [emphasis added] will happen, it will be done for him.”

Firstly, we must have faith in God. Secondly, we must believe and not doubt. But twice Jesus emphasized the importance of *speaking* faith out loud: “If anyone *SAYS* to this mountain... [and] believes that what he *SAYS* will happen, it will be done for him.” This is not hocus-pocus or some weird mind-over-matter exercise. The Bible states that the tongue has the power of life and death (Proverbs 18:21). What we say matters! So often we are speaking death over our life and circumstances by contradicting what God has already

declared to be true in His Word. God's Word is living and powerful (Hebrews 4:12), and when we declare His Word in faith, life and power are released into the situation.

God assured Joshua of prosperity and success in his life if he would do three things: (1) meditate on His Word day and night; (2) be careful to do everything written in God's Word; and (3) not let the Word depart from his *mouth* (Joshua 1:8). Joshua needed to keep God's Word in his heart, in his daily practice, but he also needed to keep it in his mouth! When we confess God's Word out loud, we are agreeing with what He has already decreed about our circumstances.

God told the prophet Ezekiel to speak to a great pile of dry bones lying on a valley floor:

Then He said to me, "Prophesy to these bones and say to them, 'Dry bones, hear the Word of the LORD!'"
(Ezekiel 37:4)

What a strange command! But the prophet obeyed, and the bones listened because Ezekiel was speaking the Word of the Lord. On another occasion, Israel came to a well in the Sinai desert. Rather than draw water from the well, the Scripture says they *sang* to it! That's right, they sang to the well:

Then Israel sang this song: "Spring up, O well! Sing to it." (Numbers 21:17 NASB)

The Scriptures reveal two powerful weapons that enable God's people to overcome the devil:

They overcame him [the devil, Satan] by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony... (Revelation 12:11).

They triumphed over the devil through the blood of the Lamb (what Christ accomplished through His atoning sacrifice on the Cross) and the word of their testimony – their spoken confession of God’s Word. Their faith in Christ and their spoken word declaring what God had already stated in His Word brought them victory.

How to Use this Book

My Confession of Faith is a collection of declarations from the Word of God intended to be read aloud in much the same way that Jesus proclaimed repeatedly in the wilderness, “It is written!” It is a tool to help the believer “prophesy” like Ezekiel and speak life to the dry bones and difficult challenges of their life.

My Confession of Faith can be used in your own personal prayer time, in a small group setting, or even in larger prayer gatherings. You may choose a certain section that addresses a present need or situation, or you may read the entire book out loud at one sitting (my wife and I have done it countless times!).

So, start speaking to your mountains, prophesying to the dry bones, and singing to desert wells! The Word of Faith is near you – it is right there in your mouth.

DEAR GOD...

BECAUSE YOUR WORD SAYS THAT THE TONGUE has the power of life and death⁵ and that we overcome the devil by the word of our testimony,⁶ and since Your Word says, “Let the redeemed of the Lord say so,”⁷ therefore I, like Ezekiel, will prophesy to the dry bones of my life;⁸ and just as Jesus did in the wilderness, I will declare, “It is written.”⁹ By faith, I will sing to the dry wells around me, saying, “Spring up, O well! Sing to it!”¹⁰

The Word of Faith is near me – it is in my heart and in my mouth; therefore, with my heart I will believe, and with my mouth I will confess Your Word unto salvation.¹¹ Because I believe, I also speak – with the same spirit of faith I believe and therefore I speak.¹² You spoke the worlds into existence by Your mighty Word, and You call into being things that do not exist.¹³ You are ALWAYS

watching over Your Word to perform it.¹⁴ Your Word says that my tongue is like the pen of a skillful writer¹⁵ and that I can write Your Word on the tablet of my heart.¹⁶

Regardless of the situations in my life, I declare that You are good ALL the time and that Your mercy and love are everlasting!¹⁷ God, it is because of Your great love that we are not consumed; Your compassions NEVER fail—they are new EVERY morning; great is Your faithfulness!¹⁸ ALL of Your exceeding great and precious promises¹⁹ are “Yes” in Christ, and we say, “Amen” to each and every one of them!²⁰ Your Word is true, forever settled and firm in heaven²¹ — it is IMPOSSIBLE for You to lie!²² Even when we are faithless, You remain faithful.²³

NO CONDEMNATION

I AM A NEW CREATION IN CHRIST—ALL of the old things have passed away, and ALL things have become new in my life.²⁴ ALL of my past sins have been forgiven and cast into the sea of God's forgetfulness.²⁵ My sins and iniquities He will remember no more.²⁶ As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed all my transgressions from me.²⁷ God does not treat me as my sins deserve or repay me according to my iniquities, but He is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in love.²⁸

Jesus took all of the punishment that I deserved for my sins through His cruel death on the Cross.²⁹ The sinless One became a sin offering, bearing all of the judgment and condemnation for my sins.³⁰ Through Christ's death, I have been reconciled to God and presented to Him without blemish, holy in His sight and free from

ALL accusation!³¹ I am the righteousness of God in Christ,³² justified by the blood of Jesus,³³ so I can now come boldly into the Most Holy Place in full assurance of faith by His blood.³⁴ I am accepted in the Beloved through God's grace³⁵—He will NEVER cast out those who come to His Son Jesus Christ.³⁶

God in His great mercy has given me new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.³⁷ I have been born again through God's imperishable seed, the living and enduring Word of God.³⁸ Through faith in Jesus Christ, I have been born from above—born of God—and God is now my Father.³⁹

There is NO condemnation for those who are in Christ. NO ONE can bring ANY charge against me, for I am one of God's chosen. Because God is for me, who can be against me? I believe Christ Jesus died for me, was raised to life, and right now is sitting at the right hand of God interceding for me. NOTHING can separate me from the love of Christ. In ALL situations, at ALL times, I am more than a conqueror through Him who loved me.⁴⁰

THE BLESSING OF ABRAHAM

BECAUSE I BELIEVE IN YOUR SON, JESUS CHRIST, my Savior and Lord, I am a child of Abraham; and because I have faith, I am blessed along with Abraham.⁴¹ Since I belong to Christ, I am Abraham's seed, and I am an heir according to the promise. Everything that was promised to Abraham is mine through Jesus Christ; like Isaac, I am also a child of promise.⁴² As a child of Abraham, You have promised to bless me: my children will be blessed, the works of my hands will be blessed, I will be blessed when I go out and when I come in, my house will be blessed, and my crops will be blessed. You will bless me and make me a blessing to nations.⁴³

You have blessed me with EVERY spiritual blessing in the heavenly realms in Christ.⁴⁴ ALL the peoples on the earth will see that I am called by Your Name, and they will fear You. You will give me descendants like the stars in the sky, and they will take possession of the cities of their enemies; through them, ALL nations on the earth will be blessed. You have made me the head and not

the tail. I will ALWAYS be at the top, NEVER at the bottom. I will be fruitful and prosperous, and I will lend to nations but borrow from none. I will have abundant prosperity so that I can be a blessing to many and meet the needs of others. Our barns will be filled with EVERY kind of provision. Our sheep will increase by thousands, by tens of thousands in our fields; there will be NO breaching of walls, NO going into captivity, NO cry of distress in our streets. Blessed are the people whose God is the LORD.⁴⁵

IDENTITY IN CHRIST

I AM NOT DEFINED BY WHO PEOPLE OR THE DEVIL say I am; I am not even defined by what I may think about myself – my true identity is defined by what God says about me in His Word. Let God be true, and every man a liar!⁴⁶ God's Word tells me that I am fearfully and wonderfully made⁴⁷ by God in His own image.⁴⁸ I am a child of God,⁴⁹ loved by my heavenly Father with the same love He has for His Son Jesus Christ.⁵⁰ And Jesus loves me just as the Father loved Him.⁵¹ God's love for me is unconditional, unending, and everlasting;⁵² He shows love to a thousand generations of those who love Him.⁵³

I have been chosen by God in Christ before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in His sight; I have redemption and forgiveness of sins through the blood of Jesus.⁵⁴ I am a new creation in Christ; I have been reconciled to God and I have become the

righteousness of God in Christ.⁵⁵ I am complete in Christ—I have been given fullness in Him, and His divine power has given me everything I need for life and godliness.⁵⁶ I have been sealed with God’s Holy Spirit and raised up with Christ; I am now seated with Christ in heavenly places, and I am God’s workmanship created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God has already prepared in advance for me to do.⁵⁷

I am a child of the light—I do not belong to the night or to the darkness—I belong to the day.⁵⁸ He has delivered me from the power of darkness and translated me into the Kingdom of His dear Son.⁵⁹ I belong to God and His people—a chosen people, a royal priesthood, and a holy nation declaring the praises of Him who called me out of darkness into His wonderful light.⁶⁰ Because I have received the Spirit of sonship, the Spirit Himself testifies with my spirit that I am a child of God, which makes me an heir of God and co-heir with Jesus Christ!⁶¹ All things are mine —the world, life, death, the present, and the future—all are mine!⁶² And since God did not spare His own Son, but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also with Him freely and graciously give me ALL things!⁶³ Jesus is my Good Shepherd, and I am His sheep; He has given me eternal life, and I will never perish; NO ONE can ever snatch me out of His hand or out of His Father’s hand.⁶⁴

TRUST IN GOD, NOT IN MAN

I KNOW IT IS BETTER TO TRUST IN THE LORD than to put my confidence in princes.⁶⁵ I will fix my eyes on Jesus, the Author and Finisher of my faith.⁶⁶ I will not look to man to meet ANY of my needs, but I will trust solely in Him, for My God shall provide ALL my needs according to His glorious riches in Christ Jesus.⁶⁷ Like King David, I have NEVER seen the righteous forsaken, or their children begging bread.⁶⁸ The Lord is my Shepherd, and I shall NEVER be in want.⁶⁹ I will depend on the Lord and put my trust and confidence in Him; I will not depend on flesh.⁷⁰

I will call on the Lord in prayer, knowing that WHATEVER I ask for according to His will, I shall receive.⁷¹ God gives good gifts to those who ask Him⁷²—EVERY good and perfect gift comes from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variableness or shadow of turning.⁷³ There is NOTHING too hard for the Lord⁷⁴—ALL

things are possible when I believe. He is able to do immeasurably more than I ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within me.⁷⁵ When I lack wisdom, He will give me His wisdom generously, without finding fault or chiding me.⁷⁶

God's Presence is with me ALWAYS, even to the very end of the age—I am never alone.⁷⁷ He will NEVER, ever leave me or forsake me; the Lord is my Helper—I will not fear what man can do to me.⁷⁸ God will keep me as the apple of His eye and hide me in the shadow of His wings.⁷⁹ My help comes from the Lord, the Maker of heaven and earth. He will not let my foot slip—He who watches over me neither slumbers nor sleeps. The sun will not harm me by day, nor the moon by night. The Lord will keep me from all harm—He will watch over my coming and going both now and forevermore.⁸⁰ God has sent His angels to serve those who will inherit salvation;⁸¹ the angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear Him.⁸² The Word of God says, "Let the weak say I am strong."⁸³ I can do ALL things through Christ who strengthens me.⁸⁴ I have been strengthened with power and might by God's Holy Spirit in my inner man.⁸⁵

VICTORY OVER ENEMIES

THE LORD WILL GRANT THAT EVERY ENEMY that rises up against me will be defeated. They will come at me from one direction but flee in seven.⁸⁶ Let God arise, and ALL of His enemies be scattered!⁸⁷ The Lord will march out like a mighty man, like a warrior He will stir up His zeal; with a shout He will raise the battle cry and will triumph over His enemies.⁸⁸ God's light shines into the darkness, and the darkness cannot overcome it.⁸⁹ Even when the enemy comes in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord will lift up a standard against him.⁹⁰ NO weapon formed against me will prevail, and God will refute EVERY tongue that accuses me. As a servant of the Lord, this is my heritage, and my vindication comes from the Lord.⁹¹ The battle is the Lord's, and He will give me victory over every enemy.⁹² I will not be afraid or discouraged because of this vast army. For the battle is not mine,

but God's!⁹³ Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for God my Shepherd is with me; His rod and staff comfort me. He prepares a table before me in the presence of my enemies. He anoints my head with oil and my cup overflows. Surely goodness and mercy will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.⁹⁴

Thanks be to God who ALWAYS leads me in His triumph.⁹⁵ I believe that Jesus, the Son of God, was manifested to destroy EVERY work of the devil⁹⁶ and that through His death on the Cross, He destroyed him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, and freed me from the fear of death.⁹⁷ And having disarmed the powers and authorities, He made a public spectacle of them, shaming them and triumphing over them by the Cross.⁹⁸ Jesus now holds the keys of hell and death.⁹⁹ EVERYONE who is born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that overcomes the world, even our faith.¹⁰⁰ It is not by human might or power, but by God's Spirit that EVERY mountain and obstacle is flattened.¹⁰¹

Jesus is building His Church, and the gates of hell CANNOT prevail against it.¹⁰² God has given me authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome ALL the power of the

enemy; NOTHING will harm me.¹⁰³ Because I believe, Christ has given me authority to cast out demons by the Spirit of God.¹⁰⁴ Just as Jesus taught us to pray, we declare: “Your Kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.¹⁰⁵ God’s Kingdom is forcefully advancing, breaking and driving out every dominion of darkness and evil.¹⁰⁶

Blessed be the Lord my strength, who teaches my hands to war, and my fingers how to fight: He is my goodness, my fortress, my high tower, my deliverer, and my shield; in Him I place my trust.¹⁰⁷ I am strong in the Lord and in His mighty power—I put on the whole armor of God, and take my stand against the devil’s schemes.¹⁰⁸ As a good soldier of Jesus Christ, I will fight the good fight of faith.¹⁰⁹ I stand firm with the belt of truth buckled around my waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with my feet shod and fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace; in addition to all this, I take up the shield of faith with which I can extinguish ALL the flaming arrows of the evil one; I take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God. And I pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests, persevering in prayer always for all

the saints. I know that when I resist the devil, he MUST flee from me.¹¹⁰

Lord, I praise You because You always surround me with songs of deliverance.¹¹¹ You are my King, O God; You command victories for me. Through You I will push down all my enemies; through Your name I will trample those who rise up against me. You have saved me from ALL my enemies. In God I boast all day long, and praise Your name forever.¹¹² Let the high praises of God be in my mouth, and a two-edged sword in my hand to execute vengeance and punishment on ALL of Your enemies; to bind their kings with chains and their nobles with fetters of iron; to execute on them the judgment already decreed in Your Word!¹¹³

“The Lord is a warrior; the Lord is His name. Your right hand, O Lord, was majestic in power. Your right hand, O Lord, shattered the enemy. In the greatness of Your majesty You threw down those who opposed You. You unleashed Your burning anger; it consumed them like stubble. Who among the gods is like You, O Lord? Who is like You—majestic in holiness, awesome in glory, working wonders?”¹¹⁴

FREEDOM, HEALTH, AND HEALING

BECAUSE JESUS HAS SET ME FREE, I am free indeed¹¹⁵—free from sin, oppression, sickness and infirmity, religious yokes and bondages, and anything else that would try to hinder my walk and service for God. God’s Word declares that I am free from the law of sin and death¹¹⁶—sin is no longer my master!¹¹⁷ It is for freedom that Christ set me free—I will no longer be burdened with a yoke of slavery.¹¹⁸ God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power, and He went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with Him.¹¹⁹ The same anointing of God’s Spirit has now broken EVERY yoke in my life.¹²⁰ Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty!¹²¹

God has delivered me out of the hands of ALL my enemies so that I might serve Him without fear, in holiness and righteousness

ALL the days of my life.¹²² I have been redeemed out of the hands of the enemy through the blood of Jesus – therefore, my body, soul, mind, and spirit belong to God. The devil has NO power or claim to my life. SOUND MIND

GOD HAS NOT GIVEN ME A SPIRIT OF FEAR, but of power, love, and a sound and disciplined mind.¹³¹ God has put His laws into my heart and written them on my mind.¹³² I will always be clear-minded and self-controlled so that I can pray.¹³³ I take captive every wandering, evil thought, any argument or pretension that sets itself against the knowledge of God, and make it obedient to Christ. I cast down every self-exalting imagination and every high thing in my mind that opposes God, for the weapons of my warfare are not carnal but mighty through God to pulling down and demolishing strongholds.¹³⁴

God has promised me an undivided heart;¹³⁵ I will not be double-minded, but will always serve the Lord with sincerity and singleness of heart.¹³⁶ I will have the same mind in me that was in Christ Jesus—a lowly, humble mind of a servant that looks out for the interests of others first.¹³⁷ I will not be anxious in my mind, for the peace of God which transcends all understanding will guard my heart and mind in Christ Jesus.¹³⁸ God will keep me in perfect

peace because I am trusting in Him, and my mind is steadfastly stayed on Him.¹³⁹ I will fix my thoughts on Jesus, meditating and delighting in God's Word day and night.¹⁴⁰ My mind is protected from evil or negative thoughts by the helmet of salvation – hope!¹⁴¹ Whatever is true, noble, right, pure, lovely, admirable, excellent or praiseworthy – I will think about such things.¹⁴²

I have the mind of Christ – a spiritual mind that can understand God's thoughts.¹⁴³ How precious are His thoughts toward me – so vast is their sum that they outnumber the grains of sand!¹⁴⁴ Thank You, Lord, for opening my mind to understand the Scriptures and for revealing Your thoughts to me.¹⁴⁵ I will not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but I will be transformed by the renewing of my mind.¹⁴⁶ I choose to always have in mind the things of God, not the things of men.¹⁴⁷ I set my mind on things above, not on earthly things.¹⁴⁸ The Spirit of Truth will lead me into all truth, protecting my mind from all deception;¹⁴⁹ my mind will not be led astray through the serpent's cunning from my sincere and pure devotion to Christ.¹⁵⁰ My mind will always be controlled by the Spirit, and this brings life and peace continually.¹⁵¹

HOPE IN DISCOURAGEMENTS

They will be brought up in the training and the instruction of the Lord.²⁷⁰ As believing parents, we know that our children are not unclean—they are sanctified and holy.²⁷¹ We declare that our children will believe, and will not be open to the charge of being wild and disobedient.²⁷² They will make wise choices, walking in the fear of God, fleeing youthful lusts, immorality, obscenity, filthy and foolish talk, gossip and slander, drunkenness, greed, and idolatry.²⁷³ They will pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace, along with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.²⁷⁴ They will be examples for the believers in speech, in life, in love, in faith, and in purity.²⁷⁵

When our children are tempted to leave Your path, Your Holy Spirit will convict them of sin, righteousness, and judgment.²⁷⁶ You will block their path with thorns and wall them in so that they cannot find their way. If they chase after forbidden things, they will not catch them; then they will realize that Your path was better and return to You in true repentance.²⁷⁷ You will grant them repentance leading to the knowledge of the truth, and You will bring them to their senses so they can escape the trap of the devil.²⁷⁸ Your Word will be a lamp to their feet and a light for their path, continually calling them back to the right way; they will keep their way pure

by living according to Your Word.²⁷⁹ Your Word is living and powerful, sharper than any two-edged sword, and it will bring conviction and the fear of the Lord deep within their heart.

Lord, You will surround our children with good company, for bad company corrupts good morals.²⁸⁰ They will exercise caution and godly discernment when choosing friends.²⁸¹ They will walk with the wise and grow wise and NOT be companions of fools.²⁸² Our children will NOT walk in the counsel of the wicked, but will find their delight in the Law of the Lord.²⁸³ If sinners try to entice them into wrongdoing, they will not give in to negative peer pressure.²⁸⁴

And because You do not want our children to be unequally yoked in marriage, You will bring the right believer at the appropriate time into our child's life for marriage.²⁸⁵ You desire that our children and their spouses be one in flesh and spirit, because You are seeking godly offspring.²⁸⁶ Just as Abraham sought a godly wife for his son Isaac,²⁸⁷ so we desire that our children, sons and daughters of Abraham, should marry born-again believers. Our children will be safe and secure, protected from harm and danger – NO evil or accidents can befall them outside of God's perfect will.²⁸⁸

WISDOM, REVELATION, AND GUIDANCE

THE LORD GIVES WISDOM, AND FROM HIS MOUTH come knowledge and understanding. He holds victory in store for the upright, He is a shield to those whose walk is blameless, for He guards the course of the just and protects the way of His faithful ones. He makes me to understand what is right and just and fair – every good path. For wisdom will enter my heart, and knowledge will be pleasant to my soul. Discretion will protect me, and understanding will guard me. Wisdom will save me from the ways of wicked men, from men whose words are perverse.²⁸⁹

The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge and wisdom.²⁹⁰ God, I choose to fear You, and I ask You for wisdom today; You promised that if I lacked wisdom, I could ask You, and You would give generously without finding fault.²⁹¹ Your wisdom

comes from heaven and is pure, peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial, and sincere.²⁹² It is because of Him that I am now in Christ Jesus; He has become for me wisdom from God – that is, my righteousness, holiness, and redemption.²⁹³ And in accordance with the riches of God’s grace, He has lavished on me ALL wisdom and understanding.²⁹⁴ God will fill me with the knowledge of His will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding in order that I may live a life worthy of the Lord and may please Him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, being strengthened with ALL power according to His glorious might so that I may have great endurance and patience.²⁹⁵

It is the desire of God, the glorious Father, to give me the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that I may know Him better. The eyes of my heart are being enlightened in order that I may know the hope to which He has called me, the riches of His glorious inheritance in the saints, and His incomparably great power to all who believe.²⁹⁶ Out of His glorious riches, God is strengthening me with power through His Spirit in my inner being, so that Christ may dwell in my heart through faith. And being rooted and established in love, I may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge – that I may be filled to the

measure of ALL the fullness of God. He is able to do immeasurably more than – superabundantly, far over and above – all that I could dare ask or imagine [infinitely beyond my highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams] according to His power that is at work within me!²⁹⁷ Hallelujah!

As it is written, “No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love Him” –but God has revealed it to me by His Spirit. I have not received the spirit of the world but the Spirit who is from God, that I may understand what God has freely given me.²⁹⁸ The Holy Spirit is making Christ known to me and revealing what is yet to come in the future.²⁹⁹

The triune God is my Counselor,³⁰⁰ continually teaching and guiding me in the right way, leading me in a straight path, even to the end.³⁰¹ He has promised to instruct me and teach me in the way I should go; He will counsel me and watch over me.³⁰² The Lord will show me His ways, teach me His paths, and guide me in His truth.³⁰³ He teaches me wisdom in my inmost heart.³⁰⁴ God sends forth His light and truth to guide me to His holy mountain, the place where He dwells.³⁰⁵

~to agree with God's Word
and say it out loud

Real faith speaks! God's first creative act was to speak: "Let there be light." Jesus is called the "Word of God" – He must have a lot to say! And the believer is exhorted to "hold fast to their *confession* of faith" (Hebrews 10:23).

My Confession of Faith is a collection of declarations from the Word of God intended to be read aloud in much the same way that Jesus proclaimed repeatedly in the wilderness, "It is written!"

This book is a tool to help the believer "prophesy" like Ezekiel and speak life to the dry bones and difficult challenges of life. It unlocks the secret to overcoming the devil and all his lies and accusations: "They overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony" (Revelation 12:11).
